SPONSOR A SEMINARIAN



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Cordial greetings from Mangalapuzha Seminary!

St. Joseph Pontifical Seminary Mangalapuzha, Aluva is one of the oldest major seminaries in the world. It has a legacy of three hundred and forty years. Till today, the Seminary has trained more than 5000 diocesan priests and hundreds of religious and missionary priests. We are proud to say that the process of the canonization and beatification of 12 of our former professors and students is underway. So far 64 former students of Mangalapuzha Seminary were appointed Cardinals, Archbishops, and Bishops. Thousands of zealous priests, who were students of this esteemed centre of priestly formation, are working as parish priests, religious priests, and missionaries all over the world.

The priestly formation in the seminary is for seven years: 3 years for philosophy and 4 years for theology. There were 317 resident and 90 day-students in the seminary during the academic year 2021-2022. This year 45 deacons were ordained priests for various dioceses and religious congregations.

Until recently our Seminary was running with help from various aiding agencies and individual benefactors. Most of such agencies stopped helping us as they found it difficult to find donors anymore. The only agency that still supports us is the CNEWA. As per the bookkeeping of the financial year 2020-2021, the Seminary spent Rs. 95000/- per student. As income, we receive an average of Rs 13500/- to 14500/- every year from the CNEWA. The dioceses which send their students to the Seminary pay Rs. 35000/- as a contribution towards the maintenance of each student. Thus, the contributions we receive from the above-mentioned source cover only around 60% of the total expenses. This means that the Seminary has to find extra income to cover the remaining expenses. For the last two years, we had to avail of bank and private loans. Although the Seminary has some additional revenue from the dairy and piggery farms and agriculture, it is not sufficient to meet the huge amount being incurred for the maintenance of our seminarians every year. The deficit amount per student is about Rs. 40000-45000 every year and this amount constantly keeps increasing. These financial constraints compel us to approach generous people like you with a request to financially help this esteemed Centre of priestly formation.

The staff and students of Mangalapuzha Seminary would be extremely grateful to you if you could sponsor a seminarian by contributing either Rs. 40000/-(approximately 550 US dollars) or any amount according to your ability every year towards the maintenance of our seminarians.

- you are becoming a part of the Mangalapuzha Seminary Family;
- the seminary community will pray for you every day and also will pray for your special intention;
- you remain connected to the seminary activities by visiting the seminary, staying in the seminary, participating in the daily activities of the seminary etc:
- between you and the seminarian sponsored a spiritual communion is fostered through prayer and personal contact.


