

This week we commemorate the feast days of many influential Saints of the Church.

September 18th is the Feast of St. Joseph of Cupertino. He was born into a poor family in the town of Cupertino, Italy. As a child, he struggled academically and had a difficult time focusing on his studies. However, he exhibited great devotion to God and practiced intense austerities and penances. He is known as the "Flying Saint" because of his ability to levitate.

September 21st is the Feast of St. Matthew the Evangelist. He was a much-hated tax collector, but immediately followed Jesus when he was called. Matthew's background gave him familiarity with records and meticulous attention to detail, reflected in the genealogy of Jesus. He portrays Jesus as someone who reaches out to sinners with mercy and offers them forgiveness, healing, and the opportunity for a renewed life. St. Matthew is depicted as a winged man derived from the vision of the four living creatures described in the book of Ezekiel and the book of Revelation.

September 23rd is the Feast of St. Padre Pio. He is known for his deep spirituality and piety and received the stigmata, numerous visions, had the gift of bilocation. He is said to have had the ability to read souls during Confession.

From these Saints we see that God looked beyond their weakness, sins and sufferings and elevated them to become great Saints with the ability to levitate, write the Gospel and bilocate because of their deep love for God and the desire to be holy.
