In 1926 Pope Pius XI instituted this day to be celebrated in all the local Churches as the feast of catholicity and universal solidarity so that Christians all over the world will recognize their common responsibility with regard to their mission to be messengers of Christ and evangelists in the world. During this pandemic, let us make an effort to participate in some kind of Mission or outreach program which will help our lesser fortunate brothers and sisters in the world. On that same note, **October 18th** is the feast of **St. Luke the Evangelist**. Tradition tells us that St. Luke was the son of pagan parents, possibly born a slave, and was one of the earliest converts. St. Luke was also a Physician and the only Gentile who wrote in the Bible (a Gospel and Acts of the Apostles). It is also believed that he painted the icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help.
