From the Pastor's Desk



Beloved OLPH family members,

On **Sunday, November I**st, we begin the **Season of the Dedication of the Church**. The last four weeks of the liturgical year belong to this season. In the beginning of this season, we remember Jesus offering the Church, His spouse, to the Father after the last judgement. This season reminds us that Christians are called to attain eternal glory through the Church.

We also commemorate **November 1**st as **"All Saints Day"**. The CCC (2683) teaches us that "the witnesses who have preceded us into the kingdom, especially those whom the Church recognizes as saints, share in the living tradition of prayer by the example of their lives, the transmission of their writings, and their prayer today. They contemplate God, praise him and constantly care for those whom they have left on earth. When they entered into the joy of their Master, they were "put in charge of many things." Their intercession is their most exalted service to God's plan. We can and should ask them to intercede for us and for the whole world.

The Church commemorates **November 3rd** as **"All Souls Day"**. In fact, the whole month of November is dedicated to praying for the souls in purgatory. The CCC (1030) teaches us that "all who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. Souls in purgatory can intercede for us, but cannot pray for themselves. Therefore our prayers for those souls are helpful to them, but also making their intercession for us effective (CCC 958).

Beloved OLPH Families:

How blessed we are! We have been chosen to create History. The impossible is being made possible, because "nothing is impossible for God" (Luke 1:37). Our moment has arrived.

I am very excited to share the status of our church building project with you all, we made considerable progress thus far. If God willing, the project is scheduled to be completed by May of 2021. Please keep on praying for the completion of the project.

As you know, we started the site development in February 2020. The site work contractor cleared trees from nearly 5 acres; planted around 60 new trees per county requirements; and demolished the old building, built a new access road from Zion Road to the building site and leveled the parking space with rough grading. The building pad is ready for the general contractor to start foundation work and erect the steel structure which is expected to be delivered in 5 trucks on November 10 and 11. The financing bank performed the first inspection of the construction progress and concurred.

We executed the contract with the general contractor who developed the preliminary construction schedule. The contractor will start the foundation work after the on-site meeting with county inspectors. He already set up a trailer for office and a dumpster.

Sponsorship Program

I am thankful to each and every one of you for your generosity and support without it we would not have reached this stage and I look forward for your continued support.

We have dedicated the cash balance through the end of the year for the project's equity as stipulated by the financing bank. There are several off-budget items that need to be funded internally. We are rolling out the voluntary sponsorship program so that parish members and benefactors can contribute.

In gratitude for all that Christ has given us and the gift of being able to help, please prayerfully consider a generous commitment in support of this sponsorship program. 
