

Beloved OLPH family members,

We commemorate the feast of **St. Francis de Sales** on **January 24**th. Francis' father wanted him to become a lawyer and then, a senator in France. He was sent to Padua to study law, but after receiving his doctorate, he told his parents he wished to become a priest, much to his father's disappointment. At 35, he became the Bishop of Geneva, and was the author of many books, including, "Introduction to the Devout Life", and "A Treatise on the Love of God".

His writings were filled with his characteristic gentle spirit, and are addressed to lay people. However, St. Francis de Sales confessed that he had a quick temper, and it took him 20 years to overcome this weakness. He took seriously the words of Christ, "Learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart." His perennial meekness and sunny disposition won him the title "Gentleman Saint."

Although Don Bosco founded the Salesian order, the name "Salesian" is derived from St. Francis de Sales, and the order was originally called the Pious society of St. Francis de Sales. The following are a few quotes from "Salesian spirituality" that we can reflect upon:

- Let your passion be disciplined.
- Let your discipline be passionate.
- Keep things in perspective.
- Develop a sense of humor, one which does not offend others.


