As we prepare for the dedication of our new Church on Sept 6th, we will begin a 33-day consecration of our community to Mother Mary for her powerful intercession



Introduction to the Marian Consecration:

The Marian Consecration is the act of entrusting one's body, soul, possessions, works, and entire life to the protection, guidance, and intercession of Our Lady. In other words it means giving Mary our full permission to complete her motherly task in us, which is to form us into children of Christ. The act of consecrating oneself to Jesus through Mary marks the beginning of a gloriously new day, a new dawn, a brand new morning in one's spiritual journey. Every week of this four-week retreat, we'll read about how one of our four saints of Marian Consecration lived out his or her consecration to Jesus through Mary. The goal will be not just to read about them and their teaching but, like Mary, to ponder their message in our hearts. Throughout the next 33 days, we will grow in knowledge, love, and service and allow Mary to take us by the hand and lead us to her Son.

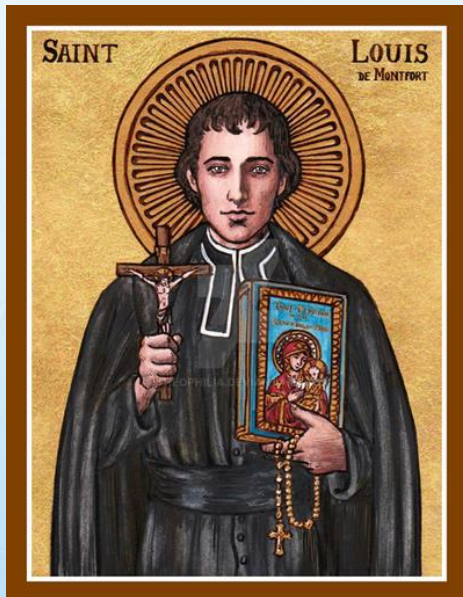

Day 1: August 3, 2021

The Passionate Saint Of Brittany
St. Louis was a preacher who channeled his fiery passion to proclaim the greater Glory of God. He tirelessly labored to bring souls to Jesus through Mary.

Day 2: August 4, 2021

St Louis's Influence on the Church
St. Louis inspired peasants to build a huge monument to the Passion of Christ in the town of Pontchateau which stood as a testament to their love for God.

Day 3: August 5, 2021

De Montfort's Consecration
St. Louis gave two key emphases in his teaching of the Marian consecration: (1) renewal of our baptismal vows and (2) an intimate gift of ourselves to Mary.

Day 4: August 6, 2021

De Montfort's Consecration
St. Louis teaches us that we should give ourselves to the Mother of God so she can help form us into saints.

Day 5: August 7, 2021

Should We Really Give Mary Everything?
St. Louis teaches us that we should give Mary everything, including our interior and spiritual goods, which are our merits, values, and good works.

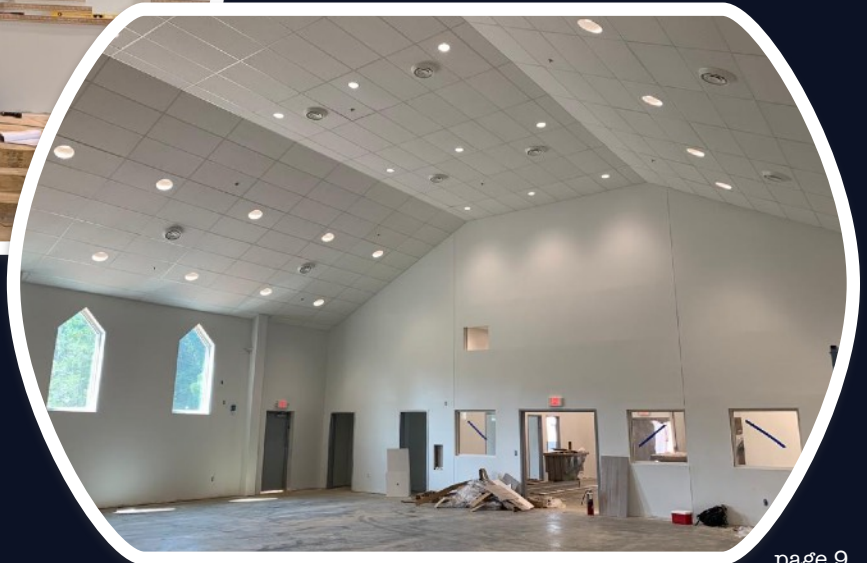
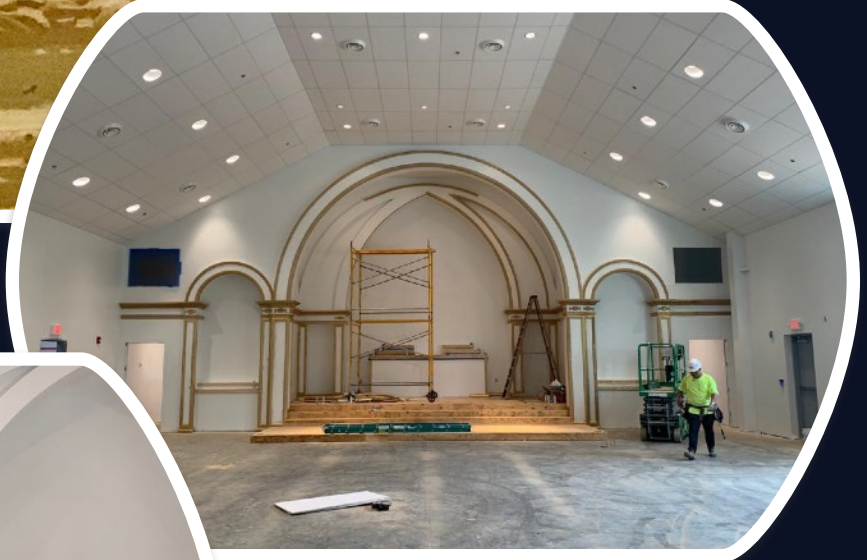
