Introduction to the Marian Consecration: The Marian Consecration is the act of entrusting one's body, soul, possessions, works, and entire life to the protection, guidance, and intercession of Our Lady. In other words it means giving Mary our full permission to complete her motherly task in us, which is to form us into children of Christ. The act of consecrating oneself to Jesus through Mary marks the beginning of a gloriously new day, a new dawn, a brand new morning in one's spiritual journey. Every week of this four-week retreat, we'll read about how one of our four saints of Marian Consecration lived out his or her consecration to Jesus through Mary. The goal will be not just to read about them and their teaching but, like Mary, to ponder their message in our hearts. to Jesus through Mary.


Day 2: August 4, 2021
