From the Pastor's Desk

Beloved OLPH family members,

August 29th is the feast of St. Euphrasia Eluvathingal. She practiced virtues of humility, charity and renunciation, and grew in holiness with the help of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Mother Euphrasia spent much of her day in the convent chapel before the Blessed Sacrament and nourished a great love and devotion for the Blessed Virgin Mary; she was an apostle of the Eucharist and of the Rosary. Let us pray to this Saint for her intercession as we move towards our Inauguration Day.

On Sunday, August 29, we begin the Season of Elijah Cross Moses. This season points to the second coming of our Lord and the ultimate success of the cross. Early Church fathers found it fitting to place the Cross concept between Elijah and Moses because Elijah would come first with the Cross and defeat evil, then lead everyone to conversion at the second coming of Christ, which is prefigured in the event of Transfiguration where Elijah and Moses appeared on mount Tabor along with Jesus. Moses represents the dead, and Elijah represents the living, and the holy Cross represents the eternal salvation of the dead and the living at the second coming of our Lord.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, we have to postpone the Installation of the Tabernacle to Sunday, September 5, 2021. Marian Consecration Day is also scheduled for the same day. I strongly urge all parishioners to make a good confession before September 6th. Please see details on pages 2 and 3.

All OLPH parishioners are invited to the Church site to place their family members' names and intentions inside a box that will be permanently placed under the tabernacle before its final installation.






