

Beloved OLPH family members,



#### Catechetical Sunday: (September 19, 2021)

## General Guidelines and Schedule

The Diocesan Bible Quiz will be part of the Faith Formation program. It will be conducted at three levels (Parish, Semifinal and Diocesan) for various age groups (Sub-Junior, Junior, Senior and Adult). There will not be a Zonal grouping as there was last year. The Dei Verbum 2022 Bible Quiz will be conducted **online** at all levels.

All CCD students from 4<sup>th</sup> grade and above are strongly encouraged and expected to participate in the Bible Quiz.

The adult group can choose either the English or Malayalam version of the quiz at all three levels. The English Bible Quiz is based on **The New American Bible**, Revised Edition (NABRE) whereas the Malayalam one is based on the **POC Malayalam Bible**. The Malayalam quiz option is only available to the adult group.
