Beloved OLPH family members,

This year the Syro Malabar Church observes the traditional **Three Day Fast from Monday February 7**<sup>th</sup> **through Wednesday February 9**<sup>th</sup>. While traditionally this fast commemorates the three days that Prophet Jonah spent in the belly of the whale, this fast is also meant to prepare us for the approaching 40 days of Lent.

The book of Jonah tells us how the voice of the Lord came to Jonah saying: "Go at once to Nineveh, that great city, and cry out against it; for their wickedness has come up before me." (Jonah 1:1) But Jonah fled from the mission that God gave him. As a result, he was swallowed by a whale where he remained for three days. Spending three days in the depths changed his attitude towards Nineveh. We also see something mystical; Jonah's descent into the water - his baptism - was, in fact, a passing through death and resurrection on behalf of Nineveh.

In the gospel of St Luke Jesus says: "For as Jonah became a sign to the men of Nineveh, so will the Son of man be to this generation" (Lk 11:30). When Jonah went and preached to the people of Nineveh the king took heed of the warning, rose from his throne, took off his royal clothes, put on sackcloth, commanded all the people to do the same and declared a fast. God had mercy on them and forgave their sins.
