Beloved OLPH family members,

In today's Gospel, Jesus says that eternal life belongs to the Good Samaritan. During this COVID-19 pandemic, we have witnessed many Good Samaritans all over the world. One foremost example of a Good Samaritan, is Fr. Giuseppe Berardelli. The 72-year old Italian priest was a beloved parish priest of his community in Casnigo in the Diocese of Bergama in Northern Italy, one of the areas, hardest hit by the coronavirus.

His community loved him so much, that when he became infected with COVID-19, his parishioners bought him a respiratory apparatus. However, Fr. Giuseppe, in the highest of priestly callings, chose to put a young person's life before his own, by giving up his respirator to save the life of that person, a complete stranger to the priest. On March 15, 2020, the "Good Samaritan", Fr. Giuseppe left his earthly abode to be forever with Jesus. Like Fr. Giuseppe, in the midst of our own suffering, let us turn our gaze towards the difficulties, pain and suffering of our neighbors around us.
