This reflection on the Immaculate Conception of Mary directly leads us to a great feast of Mary - **The Feast of the Assumption of our Lady on August 15**th. Because Mary was immaculately conceived, she was never tainted by original sin. Thus, she did not go to the grave, but was taken body and soul directly into heaven – lifted or "assumed" there by her Son. With our total consecration to Mary, we are asking for her powerful protection on us, our Community, our new Church and our families. Let us continue this act of consecration fervently, to ward off evil attacks as we get closer to the inauguration of our new Church.

On August 15th, we are also celebrating **India's Independence Day**. As we enter into the 75th year of independence, let us pray that all Indians may embrace the true meaning of freedom - freedom from narrow thinking of race and religious discrimination. As Tagore says, "where the mind is led forward by thee into ever-widening thought and action, into that heaven of freedom, my Father, let my country awake."

Day 13: August 15, 2021 - To Be an Instrument - Rather, to be Instruments The central idea of St. Maximilian Kolbe's vision of the Marian consecration is to be an instrument in the hands of the Immaculata.

Day 14: August 16, 2021 - Kolbe's Prayer of Consecration The three parts to St. Maximilian Kolbe's prayer of consecration are: (1) an invocation, (2) a plea to Mary that she'll receive us, (3) a plea to Mary that she'll use us to lead other souls for her.

Day 15: August 17, 2021 - Lover of the Heart of Jesus The deepest desire of the hearts of both Mother Teresa and the Mother of God is to satiate the thirst of the Heart of Jesus for love and souls.



Day 16: August 18, 2021 - The Gift God Gave September 10th Ön Šeptember 10th, Mother Teresa experienced a "call within a call" where she experienced Jesus' thirst for love and souls.

Day 17: August 19, 2021 - The Visions of 1947 Several months after Mother Teresa felt her "call within a call" she experienced three visions that further expressed her calling.

Day 18: August 20, 2021 - The Immaculate Heart of Mary Mary's role is to bring us face to face with the love in the Heart of Jesus crucified. When we consecrate ourselves to Mary, we give our whole self to her and Mary gives her whole self to us.

Day 19: August 21, 2021 - Heart **Pondering** Prayer Mother Teresa developed such a spiritual sensitivity and attitude by following the example of Mary and St.Ignatius of Loyola.


