### From the Pastor's Desk



Beloved OLPH family members,

We begin the **Season of Annunciation** on **Sunday, November 29, 2020**. It also marks the beginning of a new liturgical year of the Syro-Malabar Church. The four weeks in preparation to the feast of the Nativity of Jesus constitute this season. This season is also called "subbara" in Syriac language, meaning declaration or announcement. The Church recalls during these days the announcement of the birth of John the Baptist, the predecessor of Jesus, and also the joyful event of the birth of John the Baptist. As a preparation for the celebration of the mystery of incarnation, this season also recalls creation, disobedience of our first parents and its consequences, the miserable state of the broken humanity, the promise of salvation offered by God, God's covenant with humanity, and the prophecies about the Savior. During this season we also meditate on the role of Mary in the history of the plan of salvation. The readings, prayers and hymns of the season remind us to walk towards Jesus and give place in our hearts for Jesus to be born.

The **25 days "nombu"** or fasting begins on **December I**<sup>st</sup> to prepare us spiritually for the birth of Jesus. As we are in the process of constructing a Church for our Lord, let us first prepare a beautiful manger for Him in our hearts. Each family should come together and prepare a place for Jesus in your home. Please encourage children to take part in this Season of Advent to inculcate this tradition in them to be passed on to future generations.
