



From the Pastor's Desk



Beloved OLPH family members,

On **December 12th** we celebrate the **Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe**. I'm sure you are familiar with the phrase "To Jesus through Mary", but have you really experienced that? Well, here is a nation that came to know Jesus only through Mary. In 1487, people in the Aztec Empire (now Mexico City) believed in human sacrifice and even worse, child sacrifice. There was a time when 80,000 people were sacrificed non-stop for 4 days and 4 nights (this amounts to a person every 15 seconds). On December 12, 1531 that culture of death was crushed with a simple miracle. The image of Our Blessed Mother was emblazoned on the *tilma* of a man named, Juan Diego. The Aztec people, who did not have a written language, used pictures and symbols to convey messages. Our Lady's appearance to Juan Diego, and the image that she left on his *tilma* is a pictograph that the Aztec people would have understood. It is this message through Our Lady, that helped 9 million people embrace Christ and Christianity in less than 20 years.

On **December 18th** we commemorate **The Miraculous Cross at Mylapore.** St. Thomas Mount is a small hill located at Mylapore, Chennai in India. Legend has it that St. Thomas was martyred here with a bow and arrow, and is thought to have clutched a stone cross, bleeding on it during his death. According to tradition, the Cross was chiseled by St. Thomas himself, and was used by him for his personal prayer. According to ancient records, this Cross sweated blood on many occasions. Innumerable miracles have been attributed to this sacred stone cross through mere contact with it in faith, and it has caused the conversion of many unbelievers. Even today, the natural dampness on its surface is a perpetual factor of surprise and devotion. The inscription on the cross says, "Through the Cross, the Messiah brought salvation to the world".




