On **January 2**, we commemorate the feast of **St Kuriakose Elias Chavara**. St. Chavara founded the Congregation of the Mother of Carmel (CMC) for women. He also inspired schooling in churches, which is prevalent to this day and is popularly called "Pallikkoodam" – a place for education attached to the church. He wrote several books for the benefit of the faithful including his counsels to Christian families in the book "Testament of a Loving Father", which are universally applicable and relevant to this day. A man of prayer and intense charity, St. Chavara stayed in close communion with the Lord, permeating his spirituality to everyone around him. Let us pray to St. Kuriakose Chavara to intercede for us as we begin this New Year.

On **Sunday, January 3rd** we begin the **Season of Epiphany**, while the actual **Feast of Epiphany** is on Wednesday, **January 6, 2021.** The word Epiphany in Syriac is known as **Denha** meaning 'manifestation'. In this season, the Church recalls the manifestation of the Holy Trinity revealed at the baptism of Jesus for the first time. The Scripture readings during this time focus on the public life of Jesus. This period reminds us of the baptism of Jesus as well as our own baptism and the responsibilities we have undertaken with it. Let us strive to know Jesus and understand His teachings by reading the Word of God daily and participating in daily Mass.
