From the Pastor's Desk

Beloved OLPH family members,

The seven-week **Kaitha Season** commemorates the twelve apostles of Christ and their missionary activities. 'Kaitha' means summer and is the season of growth of the Church through all baptized Christians who are called to be missionaries. As we draw close to inaugurating our new OLPH Church, may we become aware of our mission to serve our community and prepare in prayer for this joyous occasion.

July 13th is the feast of Maria Rosa Mystica. The three roses represent three intentions: the white rose stands for prayer for perseverance of religious vocations; the red rose indicates prayer and sacrifice in penance for offenses committed by religious/priests; the golden rose symbolizes prayers of penance for the priests who are traitors of the Church.

July 16th is the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Hermits known as "Brothers of Our Lady of Mount Carmel" lived on Mount Carmel near the Fountain of Elijah in northern Israel in the 12th century. They had a chapel dedicated to Our Lady and celebrated a special Mass and Office in honor of Mary. In 1726, it became a celebration of the universal Church under the title of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. For centuries the Carmelites have seen themselves as specially related to Mary.

OLPH CCD SUMMER 2021 BIBLE QUIZ

General Instructions for CCD students and parents:

- The Summer 2021 Quiz is based on St. Mark's Gospel (New American Bible Revised Edition)
- The quiz is mandatory for all CCD students who are rising 4th graders to rising High School Seniors.
- Each child in a family should be registered separately
- It will be an online Quiz and therefore each student should have access to a computer with uninterrupted internet connection during the Quiz.
- It is preferable to use a computer for Registration and the Quiz to avoid glitches on a phone or tablet.
- **Last date for registration is July 2nd**
- Instructions for registration can be found below.
- The Quiz will be held on **Saturday, July 17th, 2021 at 11:30 AM.**
- A registration fee will be charged during registration. The money will be used for prizes (cash or gift card) to be given to the winners of the Quiz.
- There will be prizes for the top 3 senior students (Grades 8-12) and top 3 junior students (Grades 4-7).
- Evaluation of the Quiz will be based on highest points achieved in the shortest time. Therefore, the lesser the time spent on each question, the higher the possibility of winning (provided the answer is correct).
- Negative marking is there for wrong/missed answers and unanswered questions.
- The Quiz will be a mixture of multiple choice, multiple correct answers, True/False, pictures, match the correct answers etc
- Participation certificates will be available at the end of the Quiz to all students.

HOW TO REGISTER:

- Registration fee is \$5 per child. Please have your credit card ready before you register. Option is there to log into your PayPal account to pay. We will not accept cash or check.
- Click on the link below or on **PAGE 3** to enter the registration page.
- On the registration page, fill out the correct **FIRST AND LAST NAME OF THE CHILD (NOT PARENT'S NAME).**
- Ensure that the e-mail address you enter is correct. Each child's registration will be unique to that e-mail. Example: If you have 2 children, you will need 2 e-mails to register both children separately.
- Note down the password you use for each registration. Your e-mail will be your username.
- A verification code will be sent to your e-mail.
- Parent's name is needed only during payment with credit card (Credit card payment is secured through PayPal. If you have a PayPal account, option is there to log in to your account and pay).
- Once you have paid, you will receive an e-mail with the Quiz website link.
- Once you log in to the Quiz website, you may see the Quiz, but it will be inactive.
- Quiz will be active only on July 17th at 11:30 AM.

The following are suggestions for each family on their the day of prayer and fasting for the success of our Church construction:

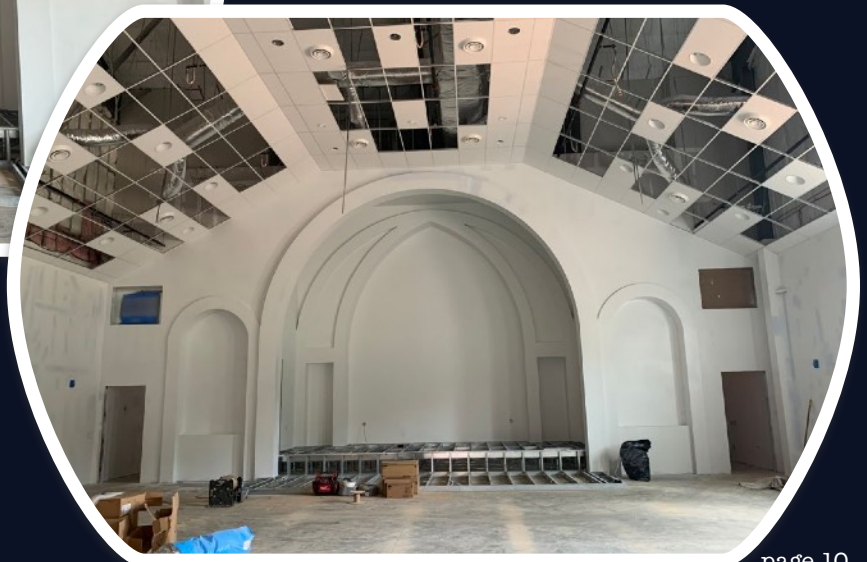
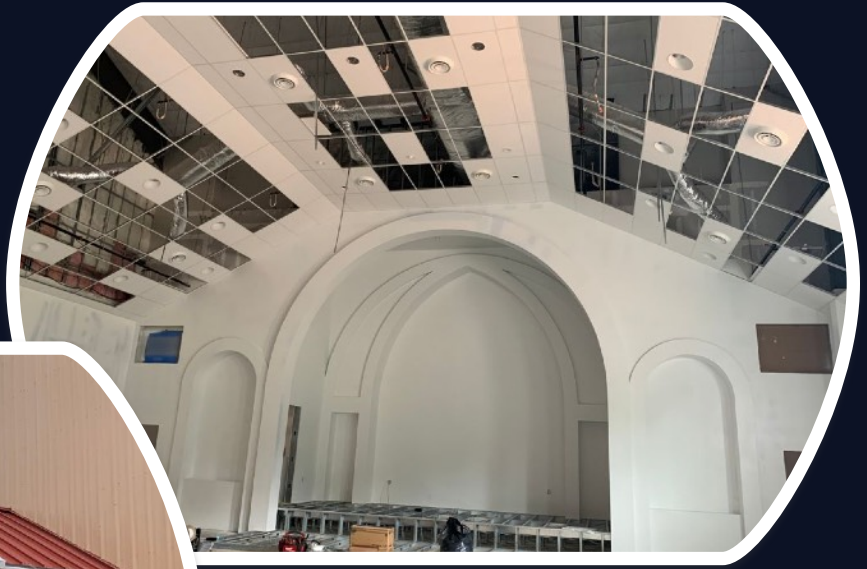
- Participate in Holy Mass (or Online Mass)
