Beloved OLPH family members,

August 11th is the feast of St. Clare of Assisi. Although Clare was born into an aristocratic and rich family, she became the foundress of Poor Clares. She was so moved by St. Francis of Assisi that she gave up everything to follow Jesus. When an attack on her convent was planned, she is known to have carried the Blessed Sacrament to the walls of the convent, and consequently, the attack was aborted. In this time of the pandemic when many people are attending online Mass, it's noteworthy that St. Clare was designated as the patron saint of television in 1958 by Pope Pius XII, because when St. Clare was very ill and could not attend mass, she was reportedly able to see and hear it on the wall in her room! Of course there was no Wi-Fi connection, but her connection to God through prayer and penance was more powerful than any wireless network we know. May St. Clare's love and zeal for God light a flame in our hearts.

It is very ironic that as we begin the second week of our 33-day Marian Consecration this week with reflections on **St. Maximilian Kolbe**, his feast day is also this week on **August 14th**. Let us intercede to this heroic saint for the success of our Church inauguration.

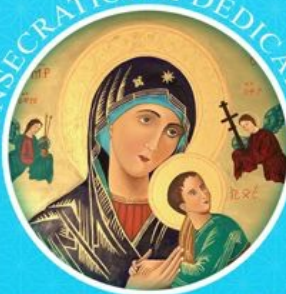

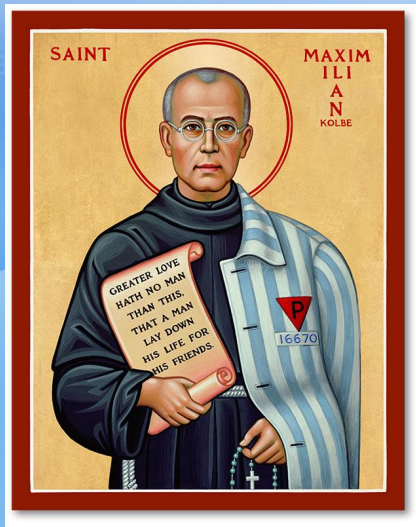

Day 6: August 8, 2021 - Should We Really Give Mary Everything?
St. Louis reminds us that Mary is not outdone in her generosity. If we are generous with her, then she'll be especially generous with us.

Day 7: August 9, 2021 - A Quick, Easy, and Secure Way to Holiness
When we see God's generosity in giving us such a great gift as the Marian consecration, we should strive to live it out and grow in holiness.

Day 8: August 10, 2021 - Who are you, St. Maximilian Kolbe
St. Maximilian Kolbe was a saint who devoted his life to the Immaculate Conception and sharing the love of Jesus.

Day 9: August 11, 2021 - Who are you, O Immaculate Conception
St. Maximilian Kolbe teaches that there are two "Immaculate Conceptions," Mary and the Holy Spirit. Mary is the created Immaculate Conception while the Holy Spirit is the uncreated Immaculate Conception.

Day 10: August 12, 2021 - Who are you, O Immaculate Conception
St. Maximilian Kolbe teaches us that Mary is the spouse of the holy spirit.

Day 11: August 13, 2021 - The Immaculata Always Does God's Will, Perfectly
St. Maximilian Kolbe reminds us that Mary always does the will of God perfectly, so we should follow her example in our lives.

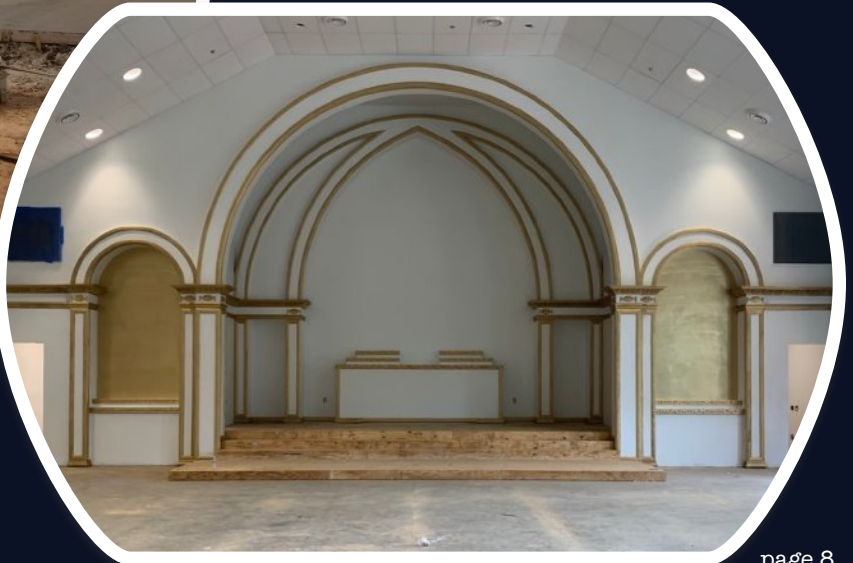
