

Beloved OLPH family members,

In the Syro Malabar rite, there are several fasts observed throughout the year. During the 5th week of Denha (Epiphany), or three weeks before Lent begins, we commemorate the **3-day Fast**, that begins this year on **Monday January 25th** and continues **through Wednesday, January 27th**. The Church observes this period of preparation in anticipation of the great fast of Lent, so that the faithful can gradually begin their ascetic exercises that will continue until Easter. These 3 days of fast are also known as the Rogation (or Supplication) of the Ninevites, as we recall how Prophet Jonah was in the belly of the whale for 3 days before preaching about repentance to the people of Nineveh, as well as the conversion and repentance of the Ninevites. Let us also observe the 3-day fast with devotion, and lift our hearts to the Lord in reparation for our sins.

On **January 29th** we commemorate the feast of **St. Stephen**, the first martyr of the Church.
